## **Gather.**

This is a dangerous drink to enjoy alone. Find a couple of brave friends and go to a bar, preferably an Irish pub.

## **Demand.**

Get the attention of the bartender. This can be done by whistling, waving, making eye contact, or yelling "Hey, you! I need a drink!". Choose wisely; the bartender can be a great friend, but a very dangerous enemy.





## Order.

Tell the bartender that you and your friends would like to do an Irish Car Bomb. If you did not decide to go to an Irish pub, the bartender may not know what the ingredients are: 1 pint of Guinness beer and a shot glass containing 1/2 oz. Bailey's Irish Cream and 1/2 oz. Jameson's Irish Whiskey.

## Pay.

Once the bartender brings your drink, you will need to pay for it. You do not want an angry bartender, so it is important to tip them well (at least 20%). Depending on where you are, Irish Car Bombs can range from five to ten dollars each. If you think you can handle more than one (most people cannot), you may want to start a tab at the bar.

## Breathe.

Take a deep breath and find some courage. Sometimes looking at your friends will help, but they usually need as much encouragement as you do. It is essential that you are your friends drink at the same time. This is a race, and the loser has to buy the next round.





## Drop.

Pick up both your pint of Guinness and your shot glass. With one hand, tilt your pint glass approximately 45 degrees; with the other hand, drop the shot glass into it. Try not to drop the shot glass from too far away, you do not want any of your Guinness to spill out.

## Drink.

As soon as you have dropped the shot glass into your Guinness, start chugging! Do not wait for the drink to settle first; it will curdle, it will start to spill, and you will look like an amateur.

## Slam.

Once you have finished drinking the entire contents of your glass, pound your empty glass down onto the bar (hopefully victoriously!). Do not attempt to stand up right away; you will either fall backward over your stool or forward onto the bar. Serious injuries are possible with either action. Repeat if necessary.
